


CEMENT-ASPHALT ANCHOR KIT

PART# 6257 FOR USE WITH ALL GRABER PARKING SYSTEMS (FOR ANCHORING INTO LAWNS, USE PART#6258)



STEP 1 - ASSEMBLY

- 1. Push rods into the holes in the anchor tube so that they are protruding equally from each side.
- 2. Place plastic cap onto end of anchor tube to keep fresh cement or asphalt from entering through the bottom.

STEP 2 - SETTING ANCHOR

- 1. Determine location of each anchor tube (at the corners of the parking system). Dig hole or remove existing cement as necessary.
- 2. Set tube with cap facing downward, so that top of anchor is flush with surface of cement or asphalt.
- 3. Pour cement or asphalt around anchor, being careful not to allow tube t0 move.
- 4. After material has set, hook connector bolt under top rod and insert into hole of parking system. Some units may require drilling a hole in the base or leg to insert the connector bolt). Secure with hex nut - do not overtighten. Cut off excess of J-connector bolt and peen top of bolt with hammer to deter removal of hex nuts.
